Simulative Test for New Immigrants

In view of Government Resolution No. 564 dated November 22, 2020 on the subject of removing barriers to employing immigrants in medical professions in Israel, the Nursing Administration is happy to announce the option of taking a simulative licensing examination that will be conducted in December 2021.

This simulative licensing examination constitutes an alternative (depending on the immigrant's choice) to a written governmental examination that is held in April 2021 and September 2021.

A simulative licensing is examination is intended for people who meet all the following criteria:

- 1. New immigrant status according to the criteria of the Ministry of Immigration and Absorption
- 2. Professional status in nursing has been recognized by the Nursing Administration / Ministry of Health as registered nurse status
- 3. Eligibility to take a governmental licensing examination is valid as of the day of the examination
- 4. Official conformations of employment in nursing for five **consecutive** years in the last decades in one of the recognized general hospitals overseas have been shown.
